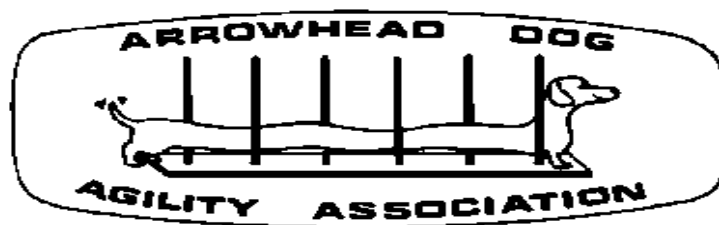

From the South:

Take I 35 north to exit #249, Boundary Ave. Turn left, follow Boundary Ave. about 3 ½ miles until it ends. The South St. Louis County Fairgrounds are on the right side of the road.

From the North or from Wisconsin via Hwy 53:

Take I 35 south of Duluth to exit #250, Highway 2. Take Highway 2 north ½ mile to Boundary Ave. Turn Right, follow Boundary Ave. about 2 ½ miles until it ends. The South St. Louis County Fairgrounds are on the right side of the road.

From the Iron Range:

Take Highway 53 south to Midway Rd. in Pike Lake. Turn right, follow Midway Rd. to Highway 2. Turn Left, Follow Highway 2 south into Proctor. Turn Left onto Boundary Ave, Go about 2 ½ miles to the end of the Road. The South St. Louis County Fairgrounds are on the right side of the road.

Please refer to the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular classes or Preferred Classes with no cross over between them allowed at this same set of trials.

### Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. ADAA will accept photocopies of the permanent or un-expired temporary height card with the entry for this trial.

### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of regulations for Agility Trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

A MACH rosette and decorated MACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH.



## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ◆ Entries close at the Trial Secretary's address, 3605 Scout Camp Road, Eveleth, MN at 6:00 p.m. on Wed. Sept. 9, 2009, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11.
- ◆ Entries must be signed at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted.
- ◆ Make checks and money orders payable to **ADAA**. Canadian exhibitors make fees payable in US funds. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.
- ◆ Telephone, telegraph, fax, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
- ◆ Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement on Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.
- ◆ All dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration are eligible to participate
- ◆ The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ◆ All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when using the warm-up jump.
- ◆ Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged.
- ◆ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee.
- ◆ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks.
- ◆ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ◆ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ◆ The Arrowhead Dog Agility Association, its agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- ◆ Entry fees for bitches that come in season will be refunded (minus recording fees ) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging.
- ◆ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

## AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

**Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
